Eligibility

- Identifies as First Nations, Métis and Inuit Peoples of Canada (Aboriginal) who are the original inhabitants of the land that is now Canada.
- Enrolled full-time in high school (including upgrading) or an accredited post-secondary institution or training program.

- Complete the online application at atcoeducationawards.smapply.ca with the required supporting documentation by the deadline. Application portal will be open August 1, 2025.
- Incomplete applications or those received after the deadline will not be considered.
